Post-Fault Maintenance Post-fault maintenance is triggered by detected faults, such as increased optical loss, degraded signal quality, or link instability. Actions include: Fault localization using OTDR or fault locators to identify the exact location of fiber damage. Immediate repair or replacement of damaged fibers, connectors, or cables to restore network functionality. Verification of system alarms and customer complaints to ensure all issues are addressed promptly. Environmental and Handling Considerations Proper environmental control and handling are critical to prevent fiber degradation: Temperature and humidity control (recommended 18–27°C, 40–60% relative humidity) to avoid micro-bending losses. Dust and particulate control through air filtration, regular cleaning of cable channels, patch panels, and server racks. Careful cable handling: avoid kinks, twists, or excessive bending; use protective caps and cases for connectors; and store cables in dry, cool locations away from chemicals or direct sunlight.
