Check wire size: Ensure the wire gauge matches the breaker rating to prevent overheating. For example, a 16A breaker typically requires 1.5–2.5 mm² wire, while a 32A breaker may need 4 mm² or larger ().

- MCB (Miniature Circuit Breaker):** Protects against overcurrent and short circuits. Common for general lighting and socket circuits.
- RCCB/RCD (Residual Current Device):** Protects against earth leakage and electric shock but does not provide overcurrent protection.
- RCBO:** Combines overcurrent and residual-current protection for individual circuits ().

Match Breaker Rating to Load

- Single-phase circuits:** Use 1P breakers for standard lighting or outlets; 2P breakers disconnect both live and neutral for higher safety ().
- Three-phase circuits:** Use 3P or 4P breakers for heavy machinery or industrial loads.
- High-power appliances:** Place higher-rated breakers closer to the main supply to manage heat a...
