

How to open a four-core optical fiber cable with a cable

- Expose the Fiber Cores** Once the jacket and strength members are removed, carefully strip the protective coating from each fiber using a fiber optic stripper. Avoid scratching or nicking the glass core, as this can cause signal loss.
- Cleave the Fibers** Use a high-precision fiber cleaver to cut the fiber ends at a precise angle. A smooth, flat end-face is essential for low-loss splicing or mechanical connections.
- Prepare for Splicing or Termination** After cleaving, the fibers are ready for fusion splicing, mechanical splicing, or termination with connectors. Ensure the fibers are clean and free of dust or debris before proceeding.
