Each patch cord should only ascend once outside and once inside the ODF frame. Avoid wrapping cords across multiple spools or leaving them hanging loosely.
- 4. Label and Color Code** Use standard color codes to identify fiber types: yellow for single-mode, orange for multimode, and aqua for laser-optimized multimode. Label both ends of each patch cord clearly to simplify troubleshooting and future modifications.
- 5. Keep Cables Clean and Protected** Always keep connectors clean and dry, leaving dust caps on until connection. Handle cords gently to avoid damaging the glass fibers inside. Regularly inspect and clean connectors to prevent signal loss caused by dust or dirt.
