- Sidewall Bearing Pressure (SWBP):** SWBP is critical when pulling multiconductor cables through bends. It is influenced by the bend radius, cable weight, and pulling tension. Larger bend radii reduce SWBP, minimizing the risk of crushing or insulation damage ().
- Planning and Pathway Design:** Effective cable pulling requires planning around pathway geometry, friction points, and support spacing. Properly supported cable trays and adherence to NEC or local codes ensure safe installation and long-term reliability ().

Best Practices

- Always follow manufacturer specifications for maximum pulling tension and minimum bend radius.
- Use rollers or sheaves at bends to reduce friction and prevent tension multiplication.
- Apply compatible lubricants if necessary, especially for long or heavy cable runs.
- Calculate SWBP for multiconductor cables to ensure the bend does not e...
