

How to quickly splice broadband fiber optic cables

Fusion splicing uses an electric arc to melt and fuse fiber ends together, creating a permanent joint with very low signal loss (typically 0.1 dB or less) and nearly zero back reflection. While slightly slower than mechanical splicing, it is preferred for long-term installations, high-speed networks, and critical broadband connections.
- Steps for Fusion Splicing:** Strip 3-5 cm of the outer jacket and buffer coating. Clean the exposed fiber with alcohol and lint-free wipes. Cleave the fiber ends precisely using a high-quality cleaver. Place fibers in the fusion splicer's V-grooves and align automatically. Activate the splicer to fuse the fibers with an electric arc. Protect the splice with a heat-shrink sleeve or splice protector. Test the splice with an optical power meter to confirm low loss.
