

# How to secure cable trays and trunking

4. Connections and Continuity Ensure all tray sections are properly joined using manufacturer-recommended connectors. Bolted connections should maintain earth continuity across gaps. Poor connections can lead to sagging, loose joints, or grounding issues, which compromise safety and system stability.
5. Material and Environmental Considerations Select trays and trunking made from suitable materials such as steel, aluminum, or PVC, depending on indoor or outdoor use, load requirements, and fire safety needs. Some trunking systems offer fire-retardant properties to contain potential cable fires.
