

How to secure cable trays in vertical shafts



Overview

For vertical cable tray runs, supports should be fixed to the building structure with a spacing preferably less than 2 meters. Properly securing cables within the trays is crucial for organization and safety. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray is used for instrumentation and control applications that require. A Vertical Cable Tray is a specialized support system designed to carry electrical and data cables securely in a vertical or riser direction. Think of it as the “spinal cord” or the “elevator shaft” for your cabling infrastructure, providing a protected and structured pathway for cables to travel. This publication is intended as a practical guide for the proper and safe* installation of cable ladder systems, cable tray systems, channel support systems and associated supports.
