

How to secure the fiber optic cable junction box

- Implement strain relief mechanisms:** Secure cables at entry points using clamps or grommets to prevent tension on the fiber itself when the outer jacket is pulled.
- Use pulling grips and lubricants during installation:** For long runs, distribute pulling force evenly and reduce friction to avoid fiber damage.
- Intermediate pull points:** For extended cable runs, use intermediate boxes to prevent excessive tensile stress.

- Protect against dust and moisture:** Ensure the box is sealed properly, especially for outdoor installations, to prevent environmental degradation.
