

How to select a 90-degree bend in cable trays

- Maintain minimum bend radius:** Always ensure the bend radius meets or exceeds the cable manufacturer's specifications to prevent insulation damage and signal degradation.
- Use prefabricated fittings when possible:** Horizontal elbows, vertical elbows, and T-junctions simplify installation and maintain consistent bend radii.
- Support at bends:** Provide additional support brackets at the bend to maintain structural integrity and prevent sagging.
