Bottom entry is common in single-storey homes where wiring travels under the floor and then rises to outlets or switches. The key is to maintain consistency within the distribution box to avoid confusion for future maintenance. Wire Composition and Color Coding A standard incoming line uses a five-wire system: Three-phase lines (A, B, C): Carry the main current, typically color-coded yellow, green, and red. Neutral line: Provides the return path for unbalanced loads, usually blue. Ground wire: Safety wire with yellow-green stripes, which protects against faults by directing current safely to earth. Correct color coding is critical for safety and compliance with electrical standards. Installation Considerations Ensure the cable size matches the load requirements to prevent overheating or voltage drops. Use certified breakers and protective devices rated for the incoming line current. Maintain clear labeling of incoming and outgoing circuits for easy identification and maintenance.
