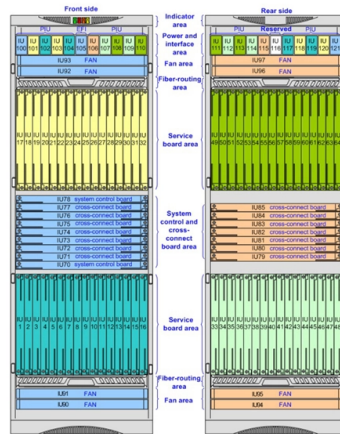


Install a whole-house fiber optic router

Step 3: Router Placement and Coverage Place the router in a central location to maximize Wi-Fi coverage. For larger homes, consider adding mesh Wi-Fi nodes to eliminate dead zones. Ensure the router is elevated and away from thick walls or metal objects that can block signals.

Step 4: Device Connection and Network Security Once the router is powered and connected, link your devices to the network. Customize your Wi-Fi name (SSID) and password for security. Regularly check for firmware updates on both the ONT and router to maintain performance and security.

Step 5: Optimization Tips Use wired Ethernet connections for critical devices like gaming consoles or workstations to reduce latency. Test internet speed and adjust router settings if needed. Consider mesh or additional access points for multi-story homes or large properties. Keep the ONT and router on a stable power source; optional backup batteries can maintain connectivity during outages.
