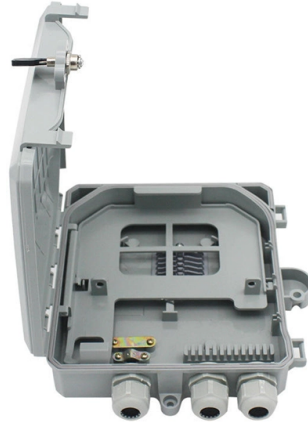

Cable Types: Only use conductors rated for open-air environments, such as Tray Rated (Type TC) or Metal-Clad (Type MC) cables. Clearances: Maintain at least 12 inches of vertical clearance above trays for installation and maintenance access (2026 NEC update). Prohibited Areas: Cable trays cannot be.
