 - Interlocking or bolted connections:** Align tray ends and secure with bolts or splice plates as per manufacturer instructions.
 - Perforated trays:** Ensure holes are aligned for proper cable ventilation and drainage.
 - Avoid gaps:** Tight connections prevent sagging and maintain structural integrity.
- Cable Installation**
 - Lay cables carefully** to avoid sharp bends or overloading.
 - Maintain proper separation** for power and data cables if required.
 - Use cable ties or clamps** compatible with galvanized surfaces to prevent corrosion.
- Grounding and Bonding**
 - Attach a grounding wire** mesh or copper/galvanized wire to the tray.
