

Installation distance of optical cable junction box

Verify the IP rating to ensure protection against water and dust ingress, and the IK rating for mechanical impact resistance. Avoid plastics like styrene (PS) for outdoor use due to poor weather resistance. Consider ambient temperature limits and avoid heat sources that could raise internal temperatures beyond manufacturer specifications.

Sealing and Moisture Prevention Proper sealing is critical to prevent moisture intrusion, which can degrade optical signals. Use high-quality gaskets and sealants designed for outdoor conditions. Inspect all cable entry and exit points to ensure they are fully sealed before closing the box. For high-humidity or wet environments, additional protective measures, such as weatherproof covers or enclosures, may be necessary.

Cable Management Organize fibers and cables inside the junction box to prevent tangling, pinching, or excessive bending. Use cable ties, trays, or color-coded markers to maintain order and facilitate future maintenance. Ensure that fiber bend radii comply with manufacturer specifications...
