The proper installation of a distribution box involves placing it at the right height to ensure safety and convenience. This height also safeguards the box from potential. In homes, the best height for installation is about 1. Leave enough space around the box for air to flow and for future. According to the "Code for Acceptance of Construction Quality of Building Electrical Engineering" GB50303-2002, the vertical distance between the bottom surface of the fixed stainless steel enclosure ip67 and the ground should be greater than 1.
