Supports can be wall-mounted using cantilever arms or ceiling-mounted with trapeze hangers. Use appropriate anchors for concrete or steel surfaces.

Step 5: Mount the Trays Place trays on supports and connect sections using splice plates. Ensure trays are level and aligned before tightening to prevent sagging or misalignment. Handle trays carefully to avoid coating damage.
