Installation Requirements Horizontal deviation: ≤ 2 mm per meter Vertical deviation: ≤ 3 mm per meter Trays must be level, plumb, and securely mounted on supports. Use brackets, threaded rods, or profile rails for ceiling or wall mounting, ensuring stability under fire conditions.

Fireproofing and Safety Measures Seal all wall, floor, and slab penetrations with fire-rated boards, firestop packs, firestop mastic, or fire-resistant mineral wool. Maintain gap areas between firestop packs ≤ 1 cm² and packing thickness ≥ 24 cm. Install fire-resistant backing plates for large openings and ensure all gaps around metal trunking are sealed internally and externally. For floor-level or slab penetrations, provide waterstops ≥ 50 mm and firestopping 20–30 mm...
