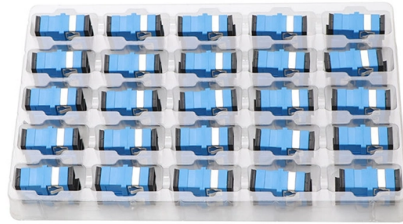

Follow local and international standards such as IEC 61537 for cable management systems. Ensure proper grounding and bonding of the trays and covers to maintain electrical safety.
- 5. Maintenance and Inspection** Regular inspection is recommended to maintain performance and durability. Check for loose fasteners, corrosion, or damage, and ensure labels and markers are visible for easy identification of cable routes.
