NEC Compliance and Cable Selection The National Electrical Code (NEC) Article 392 governs cable tray installations. Only tray-rated cables (Type TC or Metal-Clad Type MC) should be used. Metallic trays can serve as equipment grounding conductors (EGC) if properly bonded. Fill limits must be observed: power cables should not exceed 40% of the tray cross-section, and control cables 50%, to prevent overheating. High-power and low-power cables must be separated to avoid electromagnetic interference (EMI), and trays must maintain at least 12 inches of vertical clearance for installation and maintenance access. Support and Installation Practices Proper support is critical. Support spans depend on tray type, material, and cable load, typically ranging from 1.5 to 3 meters. Common methods include trapeze hangers for ceiling suspension and cantilever wall brackets for vertical runs. Cables should be laid neatly, secured with ties or straps, and organized by voltage and function. Slack should be left for expansion or future adjustments. Grounding and b...
