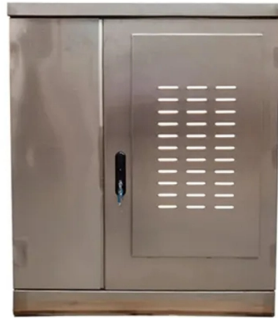

Avoid petroleum-based lubricants or detergents, as they can damage polyethylene sheaths. Managing Bend Radius and Tension Maintain the cable's minimum bend radius, typically 20 times the cable diameter under tension, to prevent signal loss or fiber breakage. Never exceed the manufacturer's maximum pulling tension, which is often around 600 pounds for outdoor cables. For long or complex runs, consider mid-span access points to re-lubricate and manage tension, or pull from the middle outwards to both ends. Protection and Termination At the end of each day, protect exposed cable ends with cable caps and tape to prevent moisture ingress. Ensure slack is provided at manholes or junction points to maintain the minimum bend radius and allow for future adjustments. Avoid pulling new cabl...
