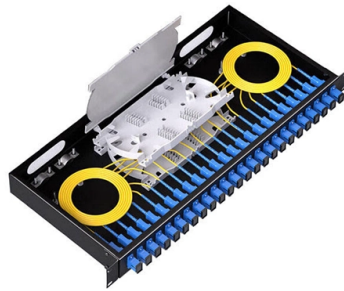


Installation process of outgoing lines from distribution boxes

Wiring Connections Identify phase wires (R, Y, B), neutral, and earth for each outgoing circuit (). Connect wires to the corresponding terminals: phase to phase, neutral to neutral, and earth to earth (). Use a wire stripper to prepare the conductor ends and crimp or tighten them securely to the terminal blocks (). Arrange wires neatly inside the box, using zip ties or cable organizers to prevent tangling and allow proper ventilation ().

Circuit Protection and Testing Install circuit breakers or fuses according to the approved load schedule, ensuring correct ratings for each outgoing line (). Perform an insulation resistance test to verify that wires are properly insulated and there are no short circuits (). Conduct a circuit on/off test with a multimeter to confirm continuity and correct operation of each outgoing line ().

Final Checks Ensure all connections are tight, terminals are labeled, and the DB is properly grounded ()....
