- 3. Mounting Height:** Extinguishers should be mounted so that the carrying handle is 3.5 to 5 feet (1.1 to 1.5 meters) above the floor, depending on the extinguisher weight, ensuring easy reach without obstruction.
- 4. Visibility and Accessibility:** The extinguisher must be clearly visible and unobstructed. Avoid placing it behind doors, equipment, or storage that could block access. Signage may be required to indicate the extinguisher location if it is not immediately visible.
- 5. Hazard Considerations:** Since distribution boxes are considered Class C hazards, ensure the extinguisher is rated for electrical fires (Class C or ABC). The extinguisher should be positioned so that a person can approach safely without standing directly in front of live electrical components.
