

Installing an optical transmitter SFP

- Insert the Module:** Gently push the module into the slot until you hear a soft click, indicating it is securely seated.
- Connect the Cable:** Attach the appropriate fiber-optic or copper cable to the module, ensuring the correct end is connected to the optical bore for single-mode or multi-mode fiber.

Post-Installation

- Power On the Device:** Once installed, power on the device and verify that the SFP module is recognized and operational.
- Check Network Connectivity:** Confirm that the link is active and data transmission is functioning correctly.
- Hot-Swapping:** SFP modules are hot-swappable, but handle them carefully to avoid damage to the port or module.
