These fixings are selected based on tray type (solid-bottom, ventilated, or ladder tray) and load requirements.
- 4. Tray Fittings and Accessories** Internal fixings also include elbows, tees, crosses, reducers, and risers to change tray direction, height, or width. Accessories like cable cleats, dividers, and covers help organize cables, prevent entanglement, and protect against mechanical damage.

Material and Installation Considerations

Material: Steel, stainless steel, aluminum, or fiberglass-reinforced plastic (FRP) are commonly used for internal fixings. Galvanized or electro-zinc coatings improve corrosion resistance.

Load Support: Fixings must support the weight of cables and trays, considering the span between supports. Ladder trays require additional support at intervals to prevent sagging.
