It specifies mechanical and environmental characteristics, fiber management systems, and installation guidelines for FTTH (Fiber to the Home) and FTTR (Fiber to the Room) networks. Compliance with ITU-T Recommendations is voluntary but ensures interoperability and adherence to best practices in optical network deployment. Other ITU-T standards, such as G.652 and G.957, define fiber characteristics and system performance for single-mode optical fibers and synchronous digital hierarchy (SDH) systems. EN Standards EN 62790 complements IEC 62790 by providing the mandatory requirements for CE marking in Europe.
