

Is the optical module plugged into the network port

An optical module must be physically inserted into the optical port of a switch or network device, and its status can be verified via the device interface or command-line tools.

Understanding Optical Modules An optical module is a hot-pluggable transceiver that converts electrical signals to optical signals for transmission over fiber optic cables and vice versa . How to Verify Connection

Physical Inspection: Ensure the module is fully seated in the port. The top side of modules like QSFP+ should face upward, and the module should click into place .

Switch Interface Check: Many switches allow you to view the optical module status through the device interface. For example, Cisco switches provide the `show fiber-ports-optical-transceiver` command to display:

- Port number
- Temperature
- Voltage and current
- Transmitted and received optical power
- Loss of signal (LOS) status

Signal Verification: A properly plugged-in module should show no LOS (Loss of Signal) and report normal optical power levels .

Differences from Electrical Port Modules Unlike electrical port modules, which use RJ45 connectors and copper cables for short distances (up to 100 meters), optical modules use fiber optics for long-distance, high-speed transmission . Optical ports can support speeds exceeding 100G and distances over 100 km, whereas electrical ports are limited to 10G and around 100 meters .
