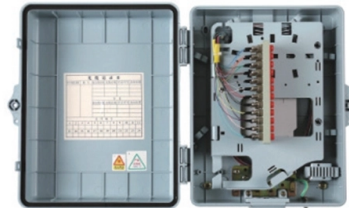

Selecting the Right Box Material: Metal boxes are used with metal conduit or armored cables and provide grounding; plastic boxes are lightweight and corrosion-resistant, suitable for non-metallic sheathed cables. Size: Box size depends on the number and gauge of wires. Each conductor has a volume allowance (e.g., 2 cubic inches per 14-AWG wire). Overcrowding can cause overheating and code violations. Preparing and Connecting Wires Identify wires: Hot wires are usually black or red, neutral wires are white or gray, and ground wires are bare or green. Strip insulation: Remove about 5/8 to 3/4 inch of insulation from each wire end, following wire nut specifications. Splice wires: Twist wires together clockwise and secure with appropriately sized wire nuts. Give each nut a gentle tug to ensure a tight connection. Grounding: Connect all ground wires together and attach to the box if it is metal. Final Steps Carefully fold the connected wires back into the box without crimping or stressing them. Attach the cover plate securely. Restore power and test the circuit to ensure proper operation. Best Practices Avoid loose connections, which can cause buzzing, intermittent power, or overheating. Use clamps or grommets to protect cable insulation where wires enter the box. Always follow the National Electrical Code (NEC) for box fill and wire sizing to maintain safe...
