Applications: Suitable for installations where cable aesthetics and support are important, such as small-diameter or sensitive cables. They are often used in commercial or industrial settings where some protection from dust or minor debris is needed.

Partial protection from dust and minor physical interference
Maintains some airflow to prevent overheating
