Level 3 Distribution Boxes Purpose and Function: Level 3 distribution boxes, also called tertiary or final distribution boxes, are the last connection point for individual electrical equipment. They deliver single-phase 220V power to tools, lighting, or small machinery and are often portable or fixed depending on site requirements.

Configuration and Components: Contains single-phase circuit breakers and leakage protection switches. Ensures individual circuit protection, preventing multiple devices from being controlled by the same switch. May include...
