These materials prevent fiber elongation and reduce microbending, which can degrade optical performance.

Water-Blocking and Protective Layers To ensure long-term reliability, optical cables include water-blocking elements, such as gel-filled compounds or dry water-swallowable tapes, which prevent moisture ingress. The outer jackets are made from HDPE, LSZH (low-smoke zero-halogen), or other UV-resistant polymers, providing environmental protection and mechanical durability.
