Lubrication and Friction Management Reducing friction is essential for long-distance pulls. Use a water-based fiber optic pulling lubricant compatible with the cable jacket, applied liberally to both the cable and conduit interior (). Avoid petroleum-based lubricants, which can degrade the cable over time. Innerduct and Fill Ratios Innerducts provide a smooth path for fiber and allow multiple cables to share a conduit. Proper fill ratios—the ratio of cable cross-sectional area to innerduct area—should be calculated to minimize pulling tension (). Corrugated innerducts are preferred for long runs as they lay flatter and stretch less during installation.
