Unlike LC or SC connectors that terminate a single fiber, MPO can accommodate multiple fibers in one connector body, making it ideal for high-speed parallel. Originally introduced for use with multi-fiber ribbon cable, MPO connectors feature a linear array of fibers in a single ferrule. They are now widely used in data centers, FTTX networks, and parallel optical transmission systems to support 40G, 100G, 400G, and beyond. What is an MPO.
