MTP vs MPO: MTP is a trademarked, enhanced version of MPO by US Conec, engineered for tighter tolerances, improved durability, and lower insertion loss, but it is fully compatible with standard MPO connectors. Connector Types: Male MPO connectors have guide pins, commonly used on trunk cables, while female MPO connectors have pinholes, often used on cassettes and patch cords.
