Overview

The 01 ER December 2025, Orange Madagascar has inaugurated a new fiber optic link 558 km. This is between Antananarivo and Mahajanga. It strengthens the national network and secures communications in the Northern region. Users can now benefit from a more. What is set to become the world's largest submarine cable system, 2Africa, has made another African landing, this time in Mahajanga in Madagascar, as it works its way up Africa's East Coast. Madagascan operator Telma and global operator Vodafone joined forces to connect Madagascar to 2Africa this. Alcatel Submarine Networks (ASN) is responsible for deploying this 45 000-kilometre cable system, designed with a capacity of 180 Tbits per second, it will interconnect 33 countries in Africa, Europe, and the Middle East. Delivering more than the total combined capacity of all subsea cables serving.
