

# Main cable wiring of distribution cabinet



## AI Overview

The main cable wiring of a distribution cabinet involves connecting the incoming feeder cable to the main protective device, distributing power to sub-circuits via MCBs and RCCBs, and ensuring proper grounding and cable management.

**Feeder Cable Selection** The main incoming cable, or feeder cable, must be sized to handle the total anticipated load of all sub-circuits in the distribution cabinet. For example, a 60A single-phase domestic distribution board typically requires a 16mm<sup>2</sup> cross-sectional area for phase and neutral conductors to safely carry the load at 230V AC . The cable should be rated for the expected current and comply with local electrical standards.

**Connection to Main Protective Devices** The incoming phase and neutral wires are connected to the main MCB or main switch, usually a double-pole MCB with the highest current rating in the cabinet, such as 63A for domestic installations . The output of the main MCB is then connected to the RCCB, which provides protection against leakage currents and electric shocks. The RCCB output feeds the individual MCBs for sub-circuits, while the neutral wires are distributed via a neutral link and the earth wires to an earth bus .

**Cable Entry and Routing** Distribution cabinets can use top-in/top-out or bottom-in/bottom-out cable entry methods. Bottom-in/bottom-out is often preferred for centralized cable management, requiring cable trenches or trays to route the feeder cables from the floor to the cabinet . Cable entry points should be protected with rodent-proof meshes or cable glands to prevent damage and ensure safe routing .

**Grounding and Safety** The ground cable should be connected first to the earth bus before connecting phase and neutral conductors. All sub-circuit loads must also be properly earthed. Cable terminations should be tightened to the recommended torque to prevent loose connections, which can cause overheating or sparks .

**Cable Management** Cables should be neatly arranged and secured to side panels or mounting bars inside the cabinet. Using structured connectors, bus bars,...
