Only one splice plate should be placed between supports to maintain structural integrity. Any signs of sagging, deformation, or damage should be addressed immediately.

Corrosion and Environmental Considerations: Inspect trays for corrosion, particularly in outdoor or chemically aggressive environments. Materials such as aluminum, stainless steel, or coated steel provide varying levels of corrosion resistance, but periodic checks are essential to prevent structural weakening. Areas exposed to unusual weather, seismic activity, or other abnormal conditions should be inspected more frequently.

Inactive or Dead Cables: Remove inactive cables to free up capacity and improve ventilation. This should be performed by qualified personnel to avoid compromising the tray system or active cabling.
