Secure it using screws or the provided attachment set. Elbow joints can accommodate a range of angles, typically from -90° to $+90^\circ$, allowing both upward and downward transitions.
- 3. Tee and Custom Configurations** When branching from a vertical riser to horizontal runs, a vertical "T" connection may be required: Create a horizontal run first, then adjust the elevation to form a vertical riser. Use elbows or mirrored bends to connect the vertical and horizontal sections smoothly. Some manufacturers provide BIM content or pre-fabricated fittings for easier integration in software and on-site installation.

Practical Tips Maintain a consistent bend radius to prevent cable stress and ensure proper cable routing. Avoid cutting all wires completely in wire mesh trays; partial cuts allow controlled bending and maintain tray strength. For multiple bends or offsets, plan the sequence to minimize sharp angles and maintain cable accessibility. Always follow manufacturer guidelines for load capacity and attachment methods, especially when using elbow fittings or splices. By following these methods, vertical bends can be executed safely...
