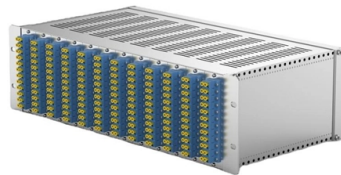

Use a chalk marker, paint pen, or adhesive tape to mark lines. Temporary markings can be removed after installation, while permanent markings help during maintenance or future cable additions.

Best Practices

Maintain Minimum Bend Radius

Ensure that markings respect the cable's bend radius to avoid stress or insulation damage.

Consistent Spacing

Keep cable spacing uniform along the curve to prevent overcrowding and allow airflow.

Reference Points

Start marking from a fixed reference point, such as the tray's entry or exit, to maintain alignment.
