- Install the ONT:** Connect the fiber optic cable from the wall outlet to the ONT and power it on. Wait for the status lights to stabilize.
- Connect ONT to Router:** Use an Ethernet cable to link the ONT's LAN port to your router's WAN port. Power on the router and confirm connectivity.
- Configure Router Settings:** Access the router interface to enable Quality of Service (QoS) or other performance settings if needed, especially for streaming or gaming.
