- Wire Mesh Trays with Inserts:** Interwoven metal wires with plastic or rubber sealing inserts reduce openings to minimize dust, liquid, and pest entry while maintaining ventilation. Best for high-density cable areas like commercial buildings and airports.
- Perforated Trays with Sealed Edges:** Trays with precision-cut holes for airflow, combined with gasketed edges or covers to prevent moisture ingress. Used in power distribution rooms and indoor industrial zones.

Firestopping and Safety Considerations When cable trays pass through walls, floors, or slabs, firestopping materials such as fire-rated boards, firestop packs, firestop mastic, or mineral wool should be used. Gaps around cables should be minimal, and backing plates may be installed for large openings. This ensures compliance with fire safety standards and prevents the spread of fire or smoke through penetrations.
