- ManageEngine OpManager: Includes switch port management and configuration monitoring.
- SolarWinds Network Bandwidth Analyzer: Combines SNMP monitoring with traffic analysis.
- Datadog Network Monitoring: Cloud-based performance and traffic monitoring.

Access Control and Configuration Managing access switch settings also involves configuring passwords and privilege levels. For example, Cisco switches allow:

- Setting enable passwords for privileged EXEC mode.
- Defining secret passwords with non-reversible encryption.
- Assigning privilege levels (0-15) to control user access. This ensures that only authorized personnel can modify switch configurations, reducing the risk of misconfigurations or security breaches.
