

Monitoring the PoE Core Switch



AI Overview

Monitoring PoE on a core switch involves tracking power usage per port, total switch power budget, and device status using SNMP, CLI commands, or network management tools.

Key Metrics to Monitor

When monitoring PoE, focus on the following metrics:

- Total Power Budget:** The maximum power the switch can supply to all PoE devices.
- Used and Remaining Power:** Current consumption versus available capacity.
- Per-Port Power Usage:** Power delivered to each connected device.
- Port Status and Errors:** Includes overloads, short circuits, denied power requests, and invalid signatures.
- PoE Device Groups:** Aggregated power usage and thresholds for groups of ports.

Monitoring Methods

- SNMP-Based Monitoring** Many network management systems, such as SolarWinds Orion or Checkmk, can poll PoE-enabled switches using SNMP. Key steps include:
 - Enable PoE polling on SNMP-supported devices.
 - Monitor PoE OIDs (e.g., 1.3.6.1.2.1.105.1.3.1.1) for metrics like current usage, port index, and event counters.
 - Use alerts and reports to detect overloads or faults.
- For devices supporting EnergyWise, PoE polling may need to be enabled manually.**
- CLI Commands** On switches like Juniper EX series, you can check PoE consumption via CLI:
 - Switch-level consumption:** show poe interface or status power consumption
 - commands display total and per-port usage.**
 - Port-level details:** Lists each port's power draw, operational status, and priority class.
- Telemetry and Analytics** For Cisco Catalyst switches:
 - Enable NETCONF on the device.
 - Configure PoE telemetry in Catalyst Center to view allocated power, load, and historical trends.
 - Telemetry provides real-time analytics and helps identify potential power shortages or misconfigurations.

PoE Detection and Safety

PoE detection ensures that power is only delivered to valid Powered Devices (PDs):

- The switch (PSE) sends discovery pulses to detect new devices.
- Measures effective resistance to confirm PD capability.
- Applies power only when a valid detection signature is present, preventing damage to non-PoE devices...
