Understanding Multi-Fiber Connectors

Multi-fiber connectors, such as MPO (Multi-Fiber Push-On) or MTP (enhanced MPO), use MT ferrules, which are rectangular blocks with multiple fiber holes. These ferrules can accommodate 4 to 72 fibers per connector, with common configurations being 12 or 24 fibers per ferrule. Alignment is achieved using guide pins molded into the ferrule, ensuring precise mating between connectors. Multi-fiber connectors are available for both single-mode and multimode fibers, with single-mode requiring tighter tolerances and an 8-degree polished end-face for optimal performance.

Installation Steps

Prepare the Fiber Cable: Strip the fiber jacket and clean the fibers carefully to remove any debris or coating residues. Ensure fibers are cut to the correct length for the connector ferrule.

Insert Fibers into the Ferrule: Place each fiber into the corresponding hole in the MT ferrule. Ensure fibers are fully seated and aligned with the guide pin holes.

Polishing the End-Face: Use a multi-fiber polishing film such as ADS-MPO, which is designed for multi-core connectors. This film allows polishing without scratches or stains and achieves a convex end-face (Coredip 0) for multimode fibers, minimizing insertion loss and reflectivity. Polishing is typically done with a polishing machine like the ATP-3000, which applies uniform pressure.

Check Alignment and End-Face Quality: Inspect the polished end-face under a microscope to ensure proper convex shape, no scratches, and correct fiber protrusion. Proper alignment is critical to maintain low insertion loss and high return loss.

Connector Mating: Connect the multi-fiber connector to its mating adapter or another MPO/MTP connector. Ensure guide pins are properly seated to maintain fiber alignment. Avoid mixing UPC and APC polish types, as this can increase signal loss.
