DHCP can be effectively managed across multiple access switches using VLAN segmentation, DHCP relays, and proper server placement to ensure reliable IP assignment and network performance.

VLAN Segmentation and DHCP Scope Each VLAN represents a separate IP subnet, and devices in different VLANs cannot communicate directly without a router. To manage DHCP across multiple VLANs, you need to create a DHCP scope for each VLAN/subnet. Assign switch ports to the appropriate VLAN using commands like `switchport access vlan` and configure trunk ports to carry multiple VLANs to the router or layer-3 switch for inter-VLAN routing.

DHCP Server Placement and Best Practices For production networks, it is recommended to place DHCP servers in the distribution layer or data center rather than on access switches shared with end-user devices. This improves reliability, security, and high availability. In smaller or lab environments, hosting a DHCP server on the same access switch as end-user devices is acceptable, but in production, it may introduce risks. Redundancy can be achieved by deploying two DHCP servers on separate access switches or in different racks, ensuring continuous service in case of failure.

DHCP Relay Configuration When the DHCP server is not on the same subnet as the clients, configure a DHCP relay (using `ip helper-address` on Cisco devices) on the router or layer-3 switch that terminates the VLANs. This forwards DHCP requests from clients to the server across subnets. Layer-3 switches can also host DHCP services directly, or a central DHCP server can serve multiple VLANs using relays.

Split DHCP Pools Across Switches For large networks, you can split DHCP pools across multiple switches or servers to manage IP allocation efficiently. Each DHCP server can handle a portion of a VLAN's IP range, and servers coordinate to avoid conflicts. This setup allows reservations for specific devices and improves scalability.
