The legs should support the full weight of the box and its internal components, including circuit breakers, fuses, and busbars, without risk of tipping or deformation.

Safety and Protection Distribution boxes must house protective devices like MCBs, RCCBs, RCBOs, and surge protective devices (SPDs) to prevent electrical faults from causing damage. Surge protection devices should be placed close to the main busbar to minimize the path for surge energy, and sensitive equipment should have dedicated sub-distribution protection. Ensure the box is installed away from wet areas and potential impact zones to maintain safety and compliance with standards like IEC 60364-5-52 and BS 7671.
