This can be: Aerial drop: Fiber is attached to existing poles. Underground drop: Fiber is pulled through a conduit or micro-trenched into the ground . At your home, a Network Interface Device (NID) or small box receives the fiber, which is then connected to an Optical Network Terminal (ONT). The ONT converts light signals into electrical data for your router or gateway, enabling high-speed internet throughout your home .Installation Considerations Professional installation is recommended to avoid damaging delicate fiber strands. Routing inside the home should minimize bends and avoid heat or high-traffic areas to prevent signal loss .Equipment placement: The ONT should be near a power source and connected to your router via Ethernet (Cat6 or better) for optimal performance .Tes...
