- SC connectors:** Larger, push-pull design, often used in legacy systems.
- MPO/MTP connectors:** Multi-fiber connectors for high-density applications, ideal for backbone or trunk links ().

Ensure that the fiber type (OS2, OM3, OM4) matches the transceiver module to prevent signal loss ().

Installation and Routing Best Practices

- Inspect cables and connectors:** Check for scratches, dirt, or bends in the fiber ends and jacket ().
- Maintain bend radius:** Avoid sharp bends to prevent attenuation; follow manufacturer specifications.
- Use proper cable management:** Employ horizontal and vertical managers, or innovative systems like Patchbox for organized routing and reduced downtime ().
- Label and document connections:** Clearly mark each patch cord and port to simplify moves, adds, and changes ().

Environmental considerations: Use LSZH jackets for indoor plenum spaces, PE jackets for outdoor, and OFNP for plenum-rated environments ().
