While slightly more expensive and potentially introducing minimal insertion loss, feed-through panels are faster to deploy and require less technical skill.
- 3. Keystone or Blank Patch Panels** Keystone panels use modular jacks that can be snapped into the panel, allowing flexibility in port types (Ethernet, fiber, or other connections). Blank panels serve as placeholders for future expansion or unused ports.

**Wiring and Termination Steps**

**Prepare the Cable:** Strip 1-3 inches of the outer jacket to expose individual wires.

**Identify Wiring Standard:** Choose T568A or T568B for consistent termination across the network.

**Terminate Wires:** For punch-down panels, use a punch-down tool to insert each wire into the corresponding slot. For feed-through panels, insert wires directly into the port or keystone jack clips, which may be tool-free.

**Organize and Label:** Use cable management features on the panel to route cables neatly and label each port for easy identification.
