Leakage protection to prevent electrical hazards, often forming part of a two-level protection system with upstream boxes. Compact and modular design, suitable for installation in residential buildings, commercial units, or small industrial setups. Outdoor suitability with rainproof tops and durable enclosures for safety and longevity. Ease of wiring and maintenance, often with knockouts for cable entry on multiple sides.

Applications Level 3 distribution boxes are widely used in: Residential buildings for distributing electricity to individual apartments or units. Small commercial premises where single-phase power is sufficient. Construction sites as part of a three-level protection system for temporary power supply. Integration with low-voltage switchgear systems, such as GCS type withdrawable switchgear, for industrial or high-rise building applications.

Technical Considerations Rated voltage typically up to 240V AC, with current ratings from 100A to 125A for residential or light commercial use. Compliance with local and international standards, such as GB7251.1-2023 for low-voltage switchgear. Modular units allow flexibility, with drawers or compartments representing independent functional units, facilitating maintenance and expansion.
